What is the Career & Transition Support Program?

The program's primary role is to facilitate delivery of enhanced career and transition support to young people aged 13-19 years which link with and complement existing programs and services on the Gold Coast. The program provides support and resources to schools, parents, employers and community agencies and aims to assist all young people to make a smooth transition from school to training, employment or further study.
